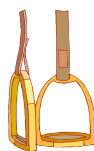

RULES OF THE NORTHERN COLORADO RIDING CLUB ALL ENGLISH SHOW

- The Northern Colorado Riding Club reserves the right to cancel this show due to bad weather or other adverse conditions.
- The Northern Colorado Riding Club reserves the right to combine, cancel, or change classes in any way.
- Juniors are required to wear protective headgear with harness at all times. Age rule to apply: Age of contestant is as of January 1.
- Riders in Lead Line may not enter any other class at this show.
- No Stallions allowed.
- A Novice rider shall not have won 3 blue ribbons in any show.
- A Green Horse is any horse, any age in his/her first year of showing.
- A Junior Horse is five years of age or younger.
- Proper attire is required except in Lead Line, Walk-Trot 10 & Under, Novice
- Exhibitors may enter more than one horse per class but high point tabulations will be calculated on one horse/one rider. Multiple entries must be declared at registration and the horse competing for high point must be declared on the registration form.

The following classes will not count for High Point:

- # 4 Ground Pole Equitation 10 & Under - Walk Trot
- #14 Lead Line Equitation 8 & Under
- #15 Walk-Trot Equitation 10 & Under
- #16 Hunter Under Saddle - Green Horse Walk-Trot
- #17 Junior Hunter Under Saddle
- #21 Hunt Seat Equitation Novice Rider Walk Trot 18 & Under
- #22 Hunt Seat Equitation Novice Rider 19 & Over
- #26 Dressage Suitability
- #27 Dressage Equitation.

EXPLANATION OF CLASSES

Hunter Hack Horses are first required to jump two fences 2' to 2' 6" in height. Jumps may or may not be set in a line. Horses will then be shown at the walk, trot, and canter in both directions. Placings for the class will be determined by allowing a minimum of 70% for work over fences and 30 % for work on the flat.

Ground Pole Equitation Exhibitors will perform a course of jumps on the ground at a trot and/or canter. Riders will not be penalized for trotting, however, credit may be given for cantering the course and performing flying lead changes. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, and ability to control and show the horse.

Cross Pole Same as Ground Pole Equitation except jumps will be cross poles.

Working Hunter Horses will jump a course of fences 2' to 2' 6" in height. Horses to be judged on manners, way of going and style of jumping.

Hunter Under Saddle All horses should be suitable to purpose. Horses to be shown at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions.

Hunt Seat Equitation Exhibitors will be judged on their riding ability. Riders will be asked to work at a walk, trot, and canter (except in walk-trot classes) in both directions and may be asked to work individually.

Dressage Suitability Horses to be worked in both directions at a walk, trot, and canter. Horses may be asked to extend or collect at all three gaits. All horses should be suitable to purpose.

Dressage Equitation Same as Dressage Suitability except riders will be judged on their riding ability.
